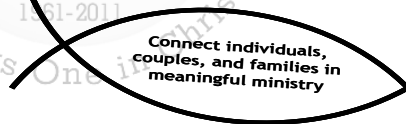

# From The Pastor

*"Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you."*

**1st Thessalonians 5:16-18**

Recently, while reading some materials on "Prayer, Spiritual Disciplines and meditation", I came across an interesting statement by Martin Luther. Luther said, that "...prayer was the most important thing a Christian could do in his/her life and that it is best to do it first thing in the morning and the last at night."

Martin Luther was known for his dedication to prayer. This attitude was formed while Luther was involved with his studies to become a priest. He wrestled with his thoughts about the reading of the Bible and the attacks made by the Devil to prevent us from doing the things that would improve our relationship with God and others.

Luther began reading the Bible when he began his studies. Luther used his Bible reading to help him as he prayed. Many of his friends and students attested to the fact that he spent a lot of time in prayer daily.

Although, I would not equate Luther's life of prayer with that of Jesus, Jesus on many occasions prayed. Sometimes in prayer for the disciples and at other times in prayer about situations and circumstances that he was involved in. On some occasions we find him stealing away early in the morning before the disciples arose to have some private time to pray in a quiet place.

Another person that we find in constant prayer was the apostle Paul. In 1st Thessalonians 5:16-18, the record says, "Be joyful always; pray continually; give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus."

Sometimes our circumstances and situations put us in a frame of mind that is not conducive to being joyful or spending productive time in prayer. When we consider Jesus, Paul and Martin Luther as models for our lives in prayer, we have the opportunity to delve into a realm of spirituality that will take us into a deeper relationship with God and others.

## **Let us pray,**

Dear, God, we realize that there are times when you would like to hear from us, but we are so busy with our things that we fail to talk to you. Give us the desire to communicate with you more often. This we ask in Jesus' name.
