

From The Pastor

"You shall love your neighbor..."

Leviticus 19:18b

How does anyone relate to their neighbor, others, or an enemy? Although it is a difficult task by giving up of ourselves in order to love others or even an enemy. This loving of others requires radical changes in us that take time and also overlook our personal comfort. It never fails that when we move towards selflessness we are required to have both faithfulness and courage. Faithfulness in serving and courage to stand firmly against adversity.

In this effort we also encounter holiness, redemption and recognition of the presence of God in our lives which moves us away from ourselves and toward partnerships with others. If we choose to make of ourselves that which is the center of our universe then we separate ourselves from God and from others and replace God with ourselves. By doing so, we eventually find ourselves standing alone. We eventually find ourselves standing alone. And God and our neighbor are no more a part of the world in which we exist.

Self-awareness is the beginning of that which makes us aware of others. Living in response to the call of Christ into discipleship ought to draw us into a transforming relationship that includes and involves others. The ability to be aware of and care for one's self also enables us to be aware of and care for others. Otherwise, the commandment to love one's neighbor as he/she loves him/herself would not be given.

Jesus who calls us into discipleship thus becomes that one how brings us face-to-face with ourselves in order that we might love ourselves. He makes us capable of loving others both like and unlike ourselves. By doing so, Jesus invites us into a radical break from the old life into the spiritual life that includes both self and others, a form of radical discipleship.

As a Christian loving one's self and others may cause us to suffer. Such suffering then leads to lifegiving relationships with God and others. Relationships that will not exploit or attack another person. Relationships that embrace the unconditional love of God which allows a person to experience him/herself, his/her desires and his/her movements as well.

This love that gives of itself because of the necessity for giving up one's self in favor of loving others. Instead of self, one ultimately loves the enemy and allows that enemy to claim one's time. Such love leads a person to lay down his/her life for his/her brother, sister, enemy and friend.

Let us pray:

Holy God, we praise You for loving us and keeping us from harm and danger. You have commanded us to love others as we love ourselves. Give us the courage and the strength that we need to fulfill every aspect of Your command toward our family, friends and enemies. Guide, guard and direct us as we seek to fulfill Your will through us.
